MEMBERSHIP CRITERIA:

1. By invitation only (your sponsoring member remains responsible for you).
2. Qualified airborne trooper, Parabats; Recces; 32 Battalion; British SAS or any other approved and respected International Unit.
3. You need to have your own motorcycle exceeding 600cc capacity.
4. Pay **R550-00.00** as annual membership fee and **R450-00** as joining fee- includes branding; colours; name tags and numbered ARMC coin. Total of **R1,000-00**. If you are joining after 1 July, your annual membership fee will reduce to **R275-00**, total of **R725-00**. Should you want your significant other to be a “Lady of Airborne”, you need to add **R450-00** for her patches.
5. As a prospective member you need to show that you are part of a core elite that stands back for no other and need to protect the honour of the club.
6. You must be comfortable with old school structures and discipline.
7. Above all – you must adhere to the Code of Honour.

Branding Details:

- e. "AIRBORNE RIDERS" top rocker on the back of waistcoat (ARMC to supply)
- f. ARMC logo beneath top rocker (ARMC to supply)
- g. "MC" centre rocker beneath logo (ARMC to supply)
- h. "REGROUP" bottom rocker (ARMC to supply)
